

Assiniboine Park Zoo to Host an Entire Weekend of Activities Dedicated to International Polar Bear Day

For immediate release: Winnipeg, February 22, 2024 – The Assiniboine Park Zoo has planned special activities on Saturday, February 24, and Sunday, February 25 to mark International Polar Bear Day and raise awareness about the important role modern zoos play in the conservation and protection of the species.

International Polar Bear Day (February 27) is an annual day of awareness created by Polar Bears International that coincides with the time period when polar bear moms and cubs are in their dens. This is a particularly vulnerable time for cubs whose survival is critically important to the species.

"International Polar Bear Day provides a chance for guests to engage with the Zoo's bears and understand our contributions to polar bear conservation, aiding their counterparts in the wild," said Dr. Stephen Petersen, Director of Conservation and Research. "Arctic warming poses a significant threat to polar bears, but learning about how each of us can contribute to their protection is a great start to help them."
